



Electricity is a type of energy that flows through electric wires. When you plug something in, electricity travels through the wires to make it work. It is wonderful - but can also be dangerous!

# BE SAFE

**NEVER TOUCH  
OUTLETS**

Keep your fingers away from plug holes.

**KEEP WATER AWAY**  
Don't use electric things near sinks, bathtubs, or when your hands are wet.

**Don't Touch Broken Cords**  
If a wire looks damaged, don't touch it — tell an adult!

**Ask Before Plugging In**  
Always ask an adult before using anything that plugs into the wall.

**KEEP ELECTRONICS ON TABLES**  
Don't put things like chargers, phones or laptops on soft places like beds.

**PULL THE PLUG, NOT THE CORD**  
**DON'T YANK CORDS!**  
GENTLY PULL THE PLUG FROM THE WALL.

**DON'T CLIMB ON ELECTRICAL THINGS**  
Stay off appliances like washing machines or heaters.

**UNPLUG THINGS YOU'RE NOT USING!**



**WHEN IN DOUBT - ASK AN ADULT!**

If something looks strange, feels hot, or smells funny, tell a grown-up right away.
