PREPOSITIONS shows the relationship between two things (noun, place, person or thing). They usually tell where, when or how things are related.

CONJUNCTIONS are joining words that show the relationships between clauses or words (the cause or result of something).

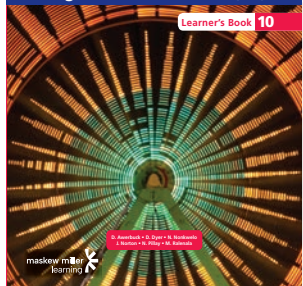
