



Max had put on his shoes ... before his socks.




He brushed his teeth ... and then put toothpaste on his toothbrush.

MASKI was still giggling to himself about how silly Max was as he switched his computer on.


Today was the day **MASKI** was going to work on his new coding game.

Bleep was standing on the STARTING block on the grid, facing forward and waiting for instructions.




‘Right,’ said **MASKI**, ‘this will be easy.’ He typed in Bleep’s commands.
