You must follow them exactly, as coding is all about following instructions carefully.’ The class were very excited and couldn’t wait to start coding.



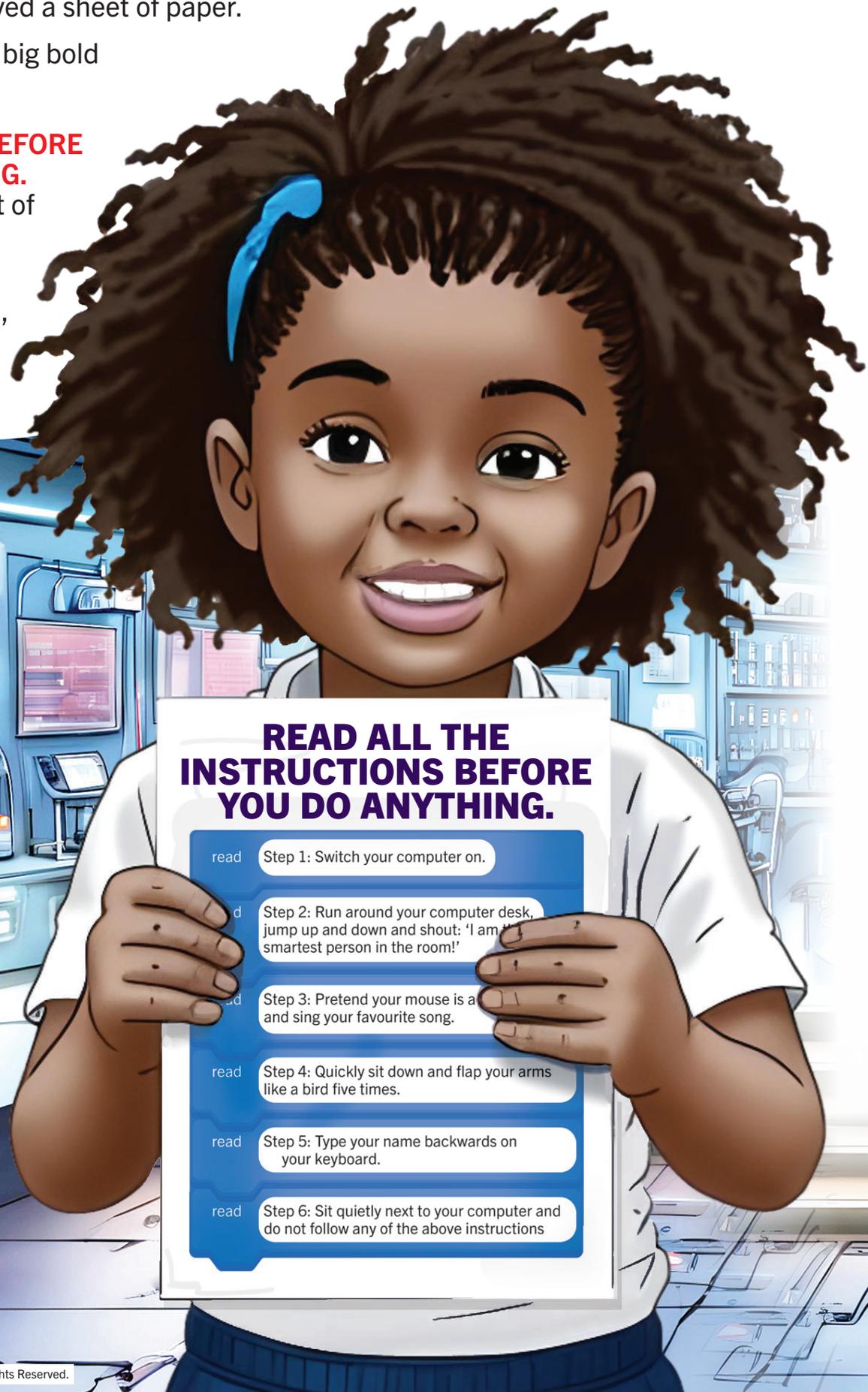
Each learner received a sheet of paper.
